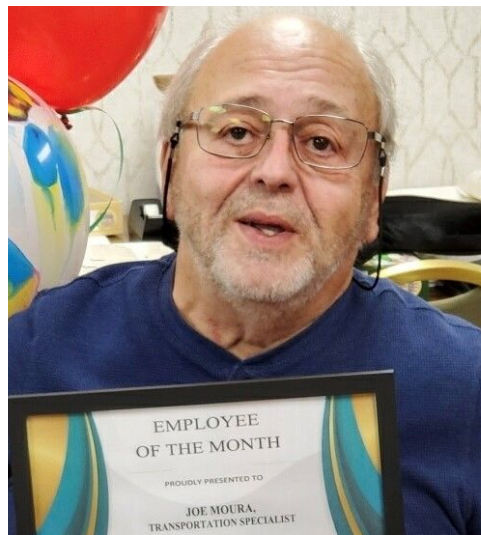
Join us at our Mardi Gras Party on Tuesday, February 13th, at 2:30 pm in the Main Dining Room. The
