Memorable Melody: 'Frosty the Snowman'

"With a corn-cob pipe and a button nose and two eyes made out of coal," a jolly, happy snowman named Frosty came to life for millions of kids in 1950 in the lyrics of this holiday song. Beloved actor and "Singing Cowboy" Gene Autry recorded the tune as a follow-up to his hit "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer." An animated TV special based on the song first aired in 1969 and has since become a timeless holiday classic.

Remember When: Million Dollar Quartet

Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis and Carl Perkins walk into a recording studio. This is no joke; the dynamic quartet made news on Dec. 4, 1956, at Sun Record Studios in Memphis, Tenn., when they happened to all be in the same place at the same time and decided to host an impromptu jam session. The local paper ran the story under the headline "Million Dollar Quartet," along with an iconic snapshot of Cash, Lewis and Perkins circling Elvis on the piano. The recording languished for years before it was discovered and released.

Popular Pages: 'The Nutcracker'

Now a seasonal staple, the 1816 story "The Nutcracker and the Mouse King" by German author E.T.A. Hoffmann was inspired by several Eastern European folk tales about wooden nutcrackers coming to life. In Hoffmann's version, a nutcracker is given to the Stahlbaum family. Fascinated by the nutcracker, young Marie dreams that her toys and dolls come to life, joining the nutcracker in a battle against the evil Mouse King. Marie and the nutcracker's enchanting adventures were adapted by French writer Alexandre Dumas in the 1840s and later used as the basis for Pyotr Tchaikovsky's ballet, which changed Marie's name to Clara and added the memorable character of the Sugar Plum Fairy. Premiering on Dec. 18, 1892, "The Nutcracker" remains the most performed ballet of all time.
