### Memorable Melody: 'You're a Grand Old Flag'

A conversation with a Civil War veteran inspired the lyrics of this patriotic march, written by Broadway star George M. Cohan for his 1906 stage musical "George Washington Jr." The rousing tribute to the American flag declares, "Ev'ry heart beats true under red, white and blue," and uses familiar lines from other famous songs, including "Yankee Doodle Boy" and "Auld Lang Syne." During World War I, the tune's popularity soared, and it became the first song from a musical to sell more than 1 million copies of sheet music.

People often think to give flowers to the women in their lives, but studies show that men appreciate floral gifts just as much—yet they're less likely to get them. You can change that oversight this month by honoring a special guy in your life with a red rose, the traditional flower for Father's Day. The custom dates back to the very first Father's Day celebration in 1910.
