According to legend, John Montagu was really only looking for time-saving nourishment when he invented the sandwich during an all-night gambling session in 1762. Montagu, Fourth Earl of Sandwich, asked for his meat to be served between slices of bread to avoid interrupting his game. So have a roast beef on rye in his honor on Nov. 3, Sandwich Day.

Remember When: U.S. Savings Stamps

For Americans who wanted to support the military during World War II but didn't have the extra funds to buy war bonds, savings stamps were an affordable alternative. The stamps were available in the amounts of 10 cents, 25 cents, 50 cents, \$1 and \$5, each designated by a different color. The purpose of the stamps was not to send mail; instead, they were collected in a booklet and eventually traded in for a war bond in a larger amount (\$25, \$50 or \$100). Sporting an inspiring image of a Revolutionary War Minuteman statue, the stamps were a patriotic reminder to U.S. residents that their support, no matter how small, mattered to the soldiers serving their country. Children were encouraged to collect the stamps as well, and the U.S. Treasury Department even produced curriculum featuring the stamps for teachers to use in their math lessons.



Sweet Potato Season

When seeking out fall flavors to enjoy in a scrumptious dessert, don't sleep on sweet potatoes! Though mashed sweet potatoes share many similarities with pureed pumpkin, subtle differences make the root veaetable a favorite for many. Because sweet potatoes are naturally sweeter than pumpkin, recipes starring the spud usually require smaller amounts of spices. Also, sweet potato pie tends to have a light, airy texture, whereas pumpkin pie is usually thick and creamy.



Wild World: Turkey Vulture

As people gather around Thanksgiving tables, giving thanks for family, friends and a tasty turkey, they may also want to say a thank-you to the turkey vulture. Like all scavengers, this large bird helps the ecosystem stay balanced by feeding on carrion. The turkey vulture somewhat resembles a wild turkey, with a dark brown and black body; a bald, red head; and an ivory-colored beak. They're one of the few bird species with a sense of smell, which helps them find food as they soar above the landscape. Also commonly called buzzards, turkey vultures are found throughout North America and in parts of South America.
