Wild World: Lynx

The lynx is one cat that likes the cold. Found in remote forests in northern Europe, Asia and North America, this solitary species stays warm thanks to its fluffy coat and large, furry paws, which function as snowshoes. The trademark black tufts on the tips of a lynx's ears help it hear prey and predators from long distances away. Lynx make their dens under ledges and in rocky crevices and are known to climb trees and swim in order to catch prey, which includes mice, squirrels, hares, fish, birds and deer.
