An Explosive Anniversary

Forty-five years ago this month, a quiet mountain peak in Washington state erupted with devastating consequences. Mount Saint Helens, which had been dormant for more than 100 years, came to life on May 18, 1980, with a 5.1 earthquake and enough ash to bring complete darkness to Spokane, Wash., almost 250 miles from the blast. The volcano has continued to erupt sporadically over the following decades, but none have been as shocking or devastating as that original eruption, which clocks in as the second largest volcanic eruption in the U.S. since its founding.
